Frequently Asked Questions about Shasta Collegiate Academy (SCA)

Is SCA accredited?

Yes! SCA is a Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) accredited high school.

Is SCA A-G?

*Yes! UC and CSU A-G approved curriculum so that graduates can be accepted
directly into the UC or CSU system.*

What curriculum is used at SCA?

*SCA uses the online program Edgenuity, it also uses online textbooks and follows the Shasta
Union High School District Course Catalog.*

How is instruction provided at SCA?

*Each SCA student is provided with a Chromebook upon enrollment. Instruction is delivered
either in person or virtually. All of SCA's curriculum is stored and accessed online.*

How often do I have to meet with my teacher?

2-3 times a week, either in person or virtually.

Can I play sports while attending SCA?



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Yes! Students may participate in California Interscholastic Federation (CIF) sanctioned sports at their neighborhood high school.

Can I attend other schools concurrently while attending SCA?

*Yes! SCA encourages concurrent enrollment at Enterprise, Foothill, and Shasta high schools.
